


The 47'C's flying bridge provides up-front seating for ten.

Computer Integrated Manufacturing (CIM), Viking handcrafts over 90% of the 47'C's component parts on-site. This ensures quality control and delivers a superbly finished yacht. For minimum maintenance, nearly all metal surfaces are powder-coated for durability. This electrostatic, baked-on process produces a finish far

more impervious to corrosive elements than either epoxy or urethane paints.

Access to the 47'C's engine room lives up to Viking's reputation for excellence by its convenient entry from the cockpit. Moreover, just-under 5' of headroom height and 360° engine access are unique for its size. Viking places all



noise-making machinery in this acoustically-isolated engine room. For example, vertical fiberglass waterlift mufflers quench exhaust noise. The engine room ceiling (salon sole) is an ultra lightweight,

structurally rigid, vacuum-bagged composite of balsa coring, sandwiched between fiberglass laminates, forming a superior acoustical shield. The Viking 47°C is exceptionally quiet.

The 47'C's 135 square foot cockpit is built to be fished. A walk-through transom door, a tuna-sized recessed fishwell, molded-in tackle cabinet with top-loading freezer, bait-prep center-sink, waterproof tackle drawers, rod holders and washdowns are standard.




PERFORMANCE, HANDLING AND FUEL EFFICIENCY: IT'S ALL IN THE HULL.

Her unique hull shape is based on the well-proven underbody that has made Viking Sportfishermen renowned for their performance. A deepened forefoot with sharp entry and stepped chines make for steady handling in unsteady seas. A fully flared bow pushes waves aside with ease to keep the bridge dry and the deck clear of spray. The aft-planing fairbody gets the 47'C on plane quickly and enables her to go faster more efficiently. Reverse chines give excellent tracking and a steady platform when fishing.

The essence of any convertible is reliable performance, fuel efficiency, and strength. The 47'C is built strong. Her structural integrity begins with fiberglass technology not found on other yachts. Only Viking sands each layer of glass before laminating the next – a technique which yields a uniform, strong laminate. The Viking hull employs a unique eggcrate-like structure of stiffeners where bulkheads and stringers intersect. Solid glass is used below the waterline; end-grain balsa coring is used in the topsides and superstructure. By using the right materials in the right places, Viking ensures maximum lightweight strength, resulting in a 47'C with high speeds, economical fuel consumption and outstanding range.

Viking's exclusive engine-mounting system uses solid steel beams bolted to dedicated engine bulkheads. This structural system not only deadens vibration and distributes engine loads evenly, it actually strengthens the hull.
