Everywhere you look aboard the stunning Viking 47 Convertible, you'll see what makes her the industry benchmark. Brand new from the keel up, her drop-dead gorgeous looks will turn heads. Composite construction, an advanced hull design and powerful turbo-diesels give her impressive range and thrilling acceleration. But what did you expect from a company that's built over 2,000 40-to 50-footers over the last three decades?

Well after the competition hobbles to the nearest lee, the 47 will run unrestrained to faraway tournament waters. You'll be able to spin around on those trophy fish for hours on end and still get back to the marina in plenty of time for weigh-in. If you cruise more than you fish, you'll rarely need to run over 100 miles offshore. But if you get the urge, it's reassuring to be on a yacht that was bred to the task. The 47 not only out-performs but clearly outclasses far larger performance convertible yachts.

All on the Bevel

Step inside the 47's Great Room salon and be awed by the practical artistry of the single-level salon-galley-dinette. Quality and elegance are radiated by the richly lacquered and marvelously detailed joinery, designer fabrics and plush, durable carpeting. Extra-large frameless tinted windows, generous 6'7" headroom and ample lighting enhance the sense of space in the already abundantly proportioned interior.

Amenities include a full surround-sound entertainment center, an L-shaped dinette with concealed TV above and, to port, a commodious L-shaped lounge featuring both a hideaway bed and rod storage below. Whether hosting a party dockside or relaxing between strikes offshore, this versatile salon does it all.

Any chef will find the well equipped galley to be efficiently laid out and completely integrated with the salon. There's ample storage space for those long voyages while either of two available galley layouts provides countertop space for rustling up a few appetizers or preparing a full-fledged banquet. Included are a full-size refrigerator-freezer with icemaker, two-burner electric range, microwave-convection oven, large sink with garbage disposal and instant hot water. The chef can even keep tabs on cockpit action through the salon's aft windows.



This new hull will eat up offshore slop like a sharp knife peels away flounder filets. Despite its thirst to perform, the 47' Convertible handles as easily as turning on a water faucet.

The well proportioned two-stateroom, two-head layout places the large Master Suite forward with its island berth, roomy cedar hanging locker, opening hatch, climate control and television. The private adjoining head features an enclosed shower, exhaust fan, opening hatch and plenty of storage space.

The guest stateroom features upper and lower berths, a full-length cedar hanging locker, reading lights, individual air conditioning and stereo controls and private head access. A washer-dryer is conveniently located in the companionway while a central vacuum system will make cleanup a breeze. With a variety of decors available, Viking's exclusive in-house interior decorator can help owners personalize the yacht of their dreams.

Our Perfectionism is on the Bine

Viking builds all of its yachts to last; a rigorous quality assurance program requires building over 90% of each yacht in-house. The finest materials available are employed by a highly skilled and specialized workforce. Composite construction throughout the yacht blends great strength with significant weight savings. For the ultimate in structural integrity, the 47 has just two major components: the hull, and a one-piece deck-superstructure extending from the bow pulpit to the cockpit liner.

To lower the yacht's center of gravity, and stabilize drivetrain alignment, Viking uses a unique system of steel engine beds mounted on low intermediate bulkheads. Viking also builds composite fiberglass fuel, water and holding tanks, eliminating the possibility of corrosion and increasing systems' reliability. To minimize sound levels, the engine room ceiling's composite construction helps contain machinery noise, creating the quietest possible onboard environment.

True Artistry is in the Details

Viking's engineering acumen is apparent in the engine room which features excellent access. And accessible equipment is likely to be better maintained, making the yacht more reliable where it counts most–far offshore. With excellent headroom, level working surfaces and powder coated engine beds and railings, the engine room is a delight to work in.

An automatic fire protection system is installed in the engine room and the lazarette while high-capacity engine cooling water pumps (with valves located at the engine room entrance) can be used to de-water the bilge. All told, it's no surprise that even our competitors point to Viking engineering as the industry standard.

Realize Your Potential

Nowhere did Viking pay more attention to getting it right than on the huge, 50'-plus class flying bridge. The centerline console—available with a Palm Beach pod helm layout—has room for an elaborate electronics suite. To pamper guests, the extended bridge overhang provides extra shade for the cockpit below while there's seating for eight on the lounges forward of the console. For added protection from the elements, a hardtop with full enclosure is available.

Advantage Angler

For the ardent angler, the spacious 135 sq. ft. cockpit takes the advantage away from the fish at the outset. There's an optional livewell next to the in-deck (optionally refrigerated) marlin-size fishbox. Engine room access, an automatic shorepower handling system, fresh and salt water wash-downs and bait prep center with freezer are all standard.

Not All Yachts Are Created Equal (or treat you equally well)

Unlike lesser boats, the Viking 47 is designed to actually put to sea and get you to your destination without fuss in real-world offshore conditions. The well-balanced hull slices matter-of-factly through head seas for a smooth, dry ride. In a following sea, she tracks as if on hidden rails. She comes up on plane easily and cruises efficiently. The 47's heritage is the thousands of Viking predecessors tried on the ultimate testing grounds—the open ocean. The resulting design—the 47 Convertible—is what many professionals today conclude is the ideal hull form for an ocean-going sportfisherman.

A few final points about what makes the Viking 47 the industry benchmark. Our semi-custom yachts can include features like a rod storage locker in place of the washer-dryer or even an office in the second stateroom.
