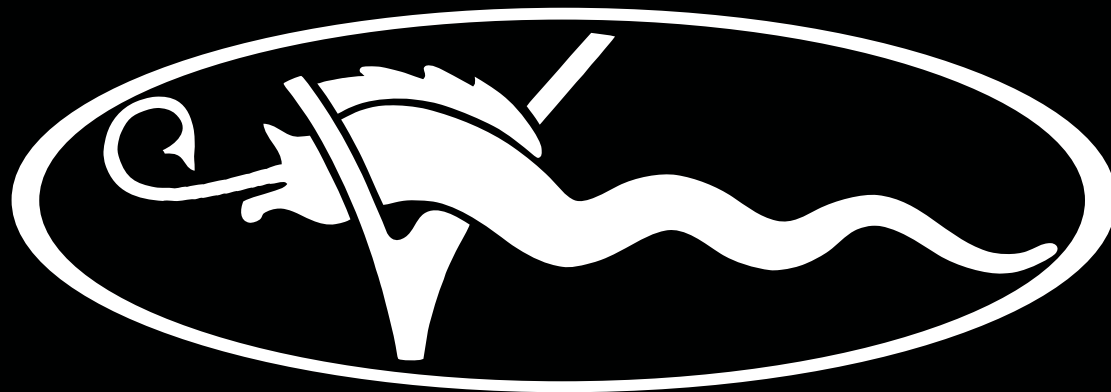

ENDLESS INNOVATION


Proving once again its status as the leading semi-custom boatbuilder in the world, the Viking Yacht Company proudly presents the Viking 90 - the flagship of our industry-leading fleet of sportfishing yachts. A magnificent feat of design and engineering, the six-stateroom, seven-head world-traveling convertible builds upon the success of previous Vikings and sets new standards in style, luxury, performance, engineering and fishability.








IN CLEAR COMMAND



Viking pioneered the Enclosed Bridge (EB) and Sky Bridge (SB) designs, and with the 90 we've raised the bar again. A one-piece windshield provides gin-clear views, and the innovative helm console is home to five large Multi-Function Displays (MFDs) in a wraparound pod. A sliding door leads to the EB's salon, which boasts walnut cabinetry, a large L-shaped lounge, a cocktail table, a pop-up HDTV, ample storage and refrigeration. The EB's aft deck features a two-person seat (with backrest A/C) and a fully equipped control station.



VIEW FROM THE TOP



The Sky Bridge console is positioned on the starboard side, with a raised electronics pod housing three MFDs. Port and starboard radio boxes flank the teak helm pod. Forward, guests can relax in an L-shaped lounge (with storage underneath); a forward fiberglass module holds a sink to port and a drink box to starboard. In the hardtop, you can add an optional drop-down electronics box as well as a box for electric teaser reels.




BUSINESS OR **PLEASURE?**



The 224-square-inch teak cockpit is battle-ready, with a reinforced sole for a fighting chair or rocket launcher. A 203-gallon transom fish box/live well anchors the business end, and the deck holds a pair of full-length insulated fish boxes and a single watertight hatch for Seakeeper access. Three seating areas face aft, so everyone enjoys the view. Optional faux teak adorns the mezzanine, upper aft deck and salon bulkhead. An inviting social space, the aft deck is appointed with an L-shaped lounge with teak table and a versatile cooking and refreshment hub with an integrated seat. An available HDTV drops down from the overhang.




ABUNDANT LUXURY

The open-concept interior design's horizontal grain walnut enhances the depth of space and its contemporary style. A staircase to starboard leads to the EB. The wet bar and galley counter's illuminated top accentuates the allure. The entertainment center with a pop-up HDTV faces a U-shaped lounge - accompanied by a cocktail table - that wraps around the port side. The lounge, which has ample storage beneath, is a perfect gathering area for family and friends, and large enough for anglers or guests to stretch out and rest when traveling long distances.




ANYWHERE YOU'D LIKE



Seating in the galley and dinette is abundant. Five stools wrap around the raised countertop, with the inboard corner remaining open for walk-up access to the galley counter and wine cooler below. The large, raised dinette with walnut table seats upwards of six. The elevated platform allows for excellent views outside and provides space for two pull-out drawers - one for rods and the other for general storage. The cooking area includes an electric range with four-burner cooktop and oven underneath, stainless steel sink with garbage disposal and a trash compactor.




OWNER'S RETREAT



The owner's stateroom is a royally appointed full-beam suite; its walk-in closet to starboard is immense. A king bed faces an HDTV with a credenza below. On the starboard side, there's a vanity/desk area (with swing-out stool) sided by two credenzas. The lounge seat on the port side is ideal for relaxing with a good book. The stateroom also features an amazing his-and-hers head with a shared shower that nearly spans the beam.



RESTFUL NIGHTS



Four more luxuriously appointed guest staterooms, including two with queen beds, await guests in the forward lower accommodations. Each has plenty of storage, an HDTV and stereo speakers. Their ensuite heads feature engineered stone countertops, overhead recessed LED lights, a medicine cabinet with mirrored doors and separate shower.



MECHANICAL MASTERPIECE



Every Viking engine room is a showpiece of mechanical engineering and expertise. But the Viking 90's has reached another level of excellence. The size itself is impressive, with over 7 feet of headroom and 40-plus inches between the optional 2635MHP MTUs. Everything is painted in Snow White for maximum visibility and ease of maintenance. There's 360-degree access around the powerplants, so you can easily get to the components and systems. The crew quarters have direct access to the cockpit, engine room and ship's system controls. Amenities include a two-bunk stateroom, galley, head with separate shower and washer/dryer combo.

OPEN BRIDGE

The Open Bridge includes a walkaround center console with an integrated forward lounge. The helm's Multi-Function Displays are flush-mounted in a recessed black acrylic panel. Three helm chairs with teak ladder backs are mounted on a raised platform for optimal visibility. Lounges on each side feature wraparound backrests. A large bait freezer forward is sided by a drink box to starboard and a sink to port. There's no shortage of storage, and the flybridge can be equipped with optional air conditioning. The Viking subsidiary Palm Beach Towers will install a custom designed and fabricated tuna tower at the owner's request.

ENCLOSED BRIDGE

The 90 Enclosed Bridge can be outfitted with - or without - a Palm Beach Towers custom tuna tower. The Enclosed Bridge features a luxurious climate-controlled second salon that includes an L-shaped lounge with a cocktail table, HDTV, refrigeration and ample storage in beautiful walnut cabinetry. The control station is forward, with a helm chair and flanking companion seating. Five Multi-Function Displays span the raised black helm pod, while recessed areas in the helm's lower panel outboard of the steering wheel are home to a variety of instruments and controls - all within easy reach of the captain.

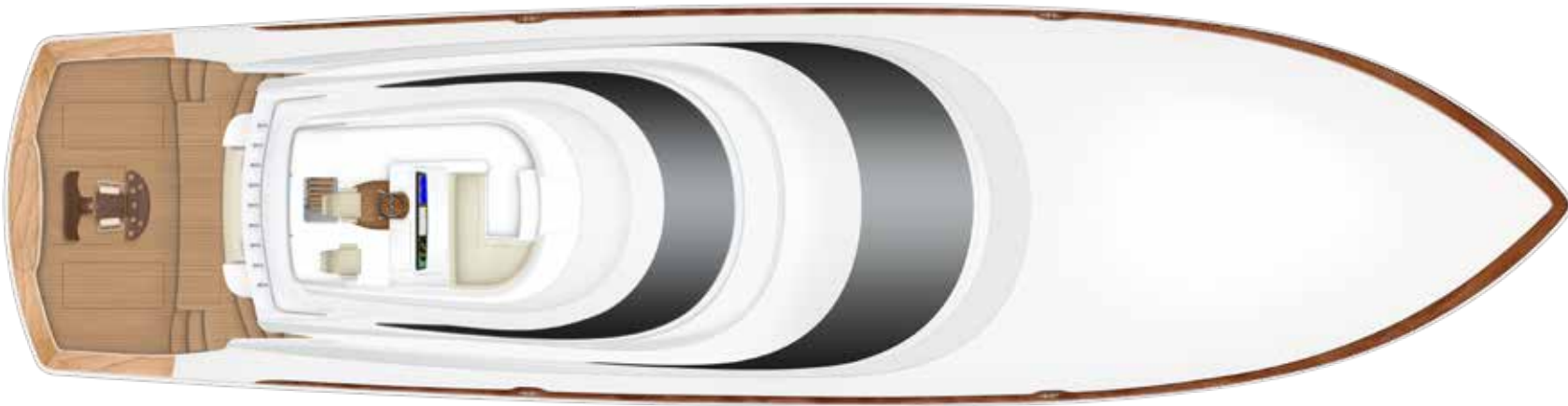

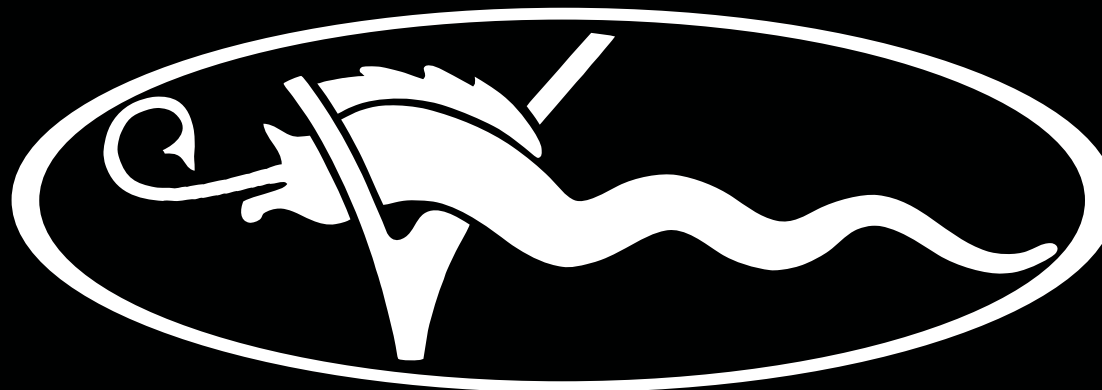
